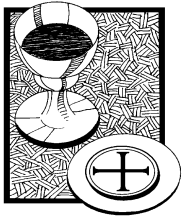

While activity certainly slows in the Parish during the summer months, inasmuch as most committees do not meet during July and August and many people take advantage of the warmer weather to travel, things do not cease entirely.

The most obvious example is, of course, our Sunday Liturgies. They continue throughout the summer, with the same times for all our celebrations. Some weekday liturgies are cancelled to allow Fr. Michael time away, of course. The full schedule, as noted elsewhere, can be viewed on our Parish website.

Another summer activity that will continue is work on our Parish Album. Now that the photographs are completed, the editing work begins. Those who purchased photographs should be receiving them; those who have not made a purchase will receive their 8 x 10 at the same time the albums are available later this year.

Our ARISE committee will work through the summer months to continue the necessary planning for our fall season launch. The current task at hand is the selection and training of those who will become our small group leaders.

The PLT has begun a process to re-write our Parish Mission Statement, necessary now that we have blended two Parish communities. Through the summer months, they are working on a draft of that new mission statement.

There will be 5 weddings this summer. And although we have already celebrated our respective anniversaries this past June 1st, it is still worth noting that on August 10th, Our Lady of Peace marks its 94th anniversary, while on September 1st, St. Kevin's marks its 50th anniversary.

This summer, the roof at our St. Kevin's Site will be re-shingled. We are hopeful too that the parking lot can be sealed and the lines repainted, since that maintenance job is overdue.

Of course, even though the CWL, K. of C. and SSVP do not formally meet in the summer, their members still strive to lead lives of holiness, according to the particular witness called forth from their respective organizations.

That is true of all of us – we each are called to be leaven in the world, in order to make our surroundings holy by the lives we lead. May we then be the best of leaven, bearing witness to Christ Who is present in all places and fills all things. His love does not grow lazy, even during the dog days of summer.
