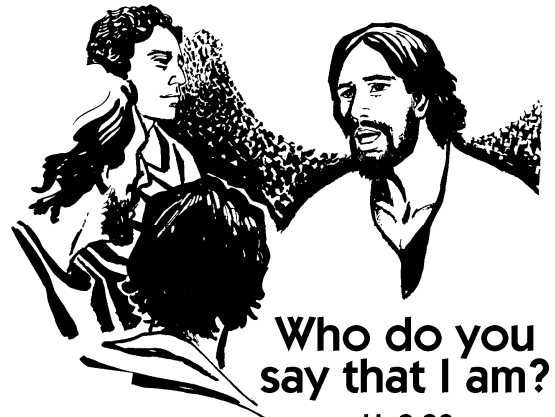

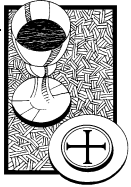

SUMMER SCHEDULE FAQ:

When is the last Parish bulletin going to be published before the summer?

The final bulletin will be distributed on the last weekend of June – June 25/26 (one more bulletin after this one). The next bulletin will be distributed on the second weekend of September – Sept. 10/11.

When does the Parish office close for the summer?

The Parish office will be open until June 30th. It will be closed for all of July and August. It will re-open at 9am on Tuesday, September 6th.

Who should I contact if I need something?

For anything non-urgent, you can leave a message on the Parish answering machine. Fr. Michael will check those messages regularly, even if he is away. For something more urgent, the fastest way to get in touch with Fr. Michael is via e-mail. Just be sure to use the ‘pastor’ address, as the ‘secretary’ address will not be checked until Trudy returns to work in September.

What about contacting Fr. Michael for funerals?

Lougheed’s Funeral Home has Fr. Michael’s contact information and can get in touch with him at a moment’s notice. If there is a need for funeral services, the funeral home is the normal place where families make first contact. If a funeral home is not involved, then an e-mail is the fastest approach. Lacking that, leave a phone message with the Parish; Fr. Michael will be in touch as soon as he can.

Will there be weekday Masses during the summer?

Yes - most days, anyway. Fr. Michael will be away at certain times (a bit of a holiday in July and a retreat in August). The Mass schedule for the upcoming week will always be posted on the bulletin board in the entranceways of our respective worship sites the weekend before. Or, if you want a bit more notice, you can always consult the Calendar Page of our Parish Website. It is already up to date for the summer, showing all Masses, Funerals and Weddings.

What about the availability of Confession?

Fr. Michael will still be available most Saturday mornings from 11am to Noon in the Confessional room at our St. Kevin Site for those wanting to celebrate

Reconciliation. To know for certain if he will be there, consult the **Calendar Page** of our Parish website. If “**Reconciliation**” does not show on a particular **Saturday**, it’s because **Fr. Michael** is unavailable at that time. **Appointments** for this **Sacrament** can also be made at any other time, simply by contacting **Fr. Michael** directly.

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

From June 5th to July 5th, most of the 1.6 billion Muslims around the world (including our sponsored family) will be observing Ramadan. During this month, Muslims fast every day from sunrise to sunset. It is a total fast - no food, no drink (not even water), no intimacy, no smoking. It is meant to be a time of spiritual discipline – of deep contemplation of one’s relationship with God, extra prayer, increased charity and generosity, and intense study of the Quran. It also tends to increase the bonds within the family, as they arise before sunrise to share a meal, and again after sunset.

The dates for Ramadan are the same every year on the Islamic calendar, but change every year on the Gregorian calendar. The reason is simply that the Islamist calendar is based on the lunar cycle, while the Gregorian is based on the solar cycle. That means the date for this observance will move about 11 days every year as measured on our calendar.

During this month, please keep this in mind if you are visiting the Alzahran family, or interacting with them in some way. It would not be appropriate to offer them food or drink this month, or to expect that they would offer you food and drink, if you were to visit them while the sun is up.

ELIZABETH CENTER:

Please note that Fr. Michael will not be celebrating Mass at the Elizabeth Center this week. However, Fr. Robert from St. Marguerite Parish will celebrate Mass there at the regular time of 10:30am.

Fr. Michael **will** celebrate Mass at the Elizabeth Center on the 4th Fridays of both July and August (July 22 and August 26) and on those 2 days, this Mass will replace the Friday morning Mass in our Parish.
