



It started in the days leading up to the May long weekend, as cool as those days turned out to be. And it has continued since, with an increased intensity and purpose: taking out of storage campers and tents and various sorts of equipment that will launch us into summer holiday mode. We're ready for it, after a long winter and spring of dedicated work. We need time to pause from that, to rest and recall that life is not just about work. We need to play and we need recreation, in the sense of being re-created. That is the rhythm of summer for many of us.

And this is good. It is, after all, the rhythm not just of our summers, but of our entire lives. We work hard throughout the week and, as God has designed, we pause on Sunday to rest and reflect and allow ourselves to be re-created anew. If we did not, we would very quickly break down and lose the joy of living. As is often said, the instruction manual the Creator gave us at the beginning is pretty clear about how we are made and how it is that we are maintained.

And so this rhythm of "work – recreation" continues on the grander scale of seasons, and so it is that we scurry about now to prepare for this time of slowing down. Funny how it takes a lot of work to prepare ourselves for rest! At least it does for me, as there is the planning and cleaning and purchasing and packing and repairing that needs to be done. But in the end, we know it is both necessary and good for us. We do it not to forget who we are, but to be reminded that, made in God's own image and likeness, we need to be respectful of our own design. That design requires us to both work hard, and to pause from working hard. At both times, God is present and is speaking to us. Perhaps it's easier to hear His voice when we are less busy and less frantic in our lives.

I sincerely hope that this summer is for all of you a peaceful time of rest, a renewing time of re-creation, and a deeper time of listening to the voice of God that speaks gentle words of love to those attentive enough to hear.
