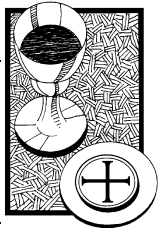

## **BREWED AND STEEPED THEOLOGY**

This fall, there will be added a new dimension to our parish life, as Fr. Michael introduces “Brewed and Steeped Theology”. It takes its name from the “Theology on Tap” genre of catechesis, but will be done over coffee and tea, rather than a beer or a shot. It will also take place in the Parish Hall of Our Lady of Peace, rather than a local bar.

Simply put, Parishioners may submit questions of a theological nature to be discussed informally over coffee and tea following one of the morning weekday Masses in Capreol. Fr. Michael will lead the sessions, which will be open to anyone who wishes to participate. Participation may mean active involvement, or simply listening while sipping a cup of java. These types of sessions tend to take on a life of their own, so it’s hard to describe them precisely.

Any question may be submitted via e-mail or, (and this gives the option of remaining anonymous) by placing it in a sealed envelope marked “Brewed and Steeped Theology” and leaving it in the collection basket. Inappropriate questions will, of course, not be accepted. The upcoming question to be discussed will be published beforehand in the Parish bulletin (without the name of the submitter).

With the final season of Arise coming this Fall, this is one attempt to provide some ongoing group discussion in an informal catechetical environment.
