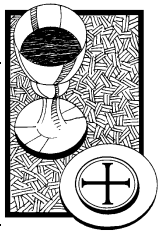

REFUGEE FUNDRAISER:

On Sun. Nov. 29 (this weekend) the voices of 60 young people will ring out in Capreol, in support of the Syrian refugee family who will join our community in the coming year.
