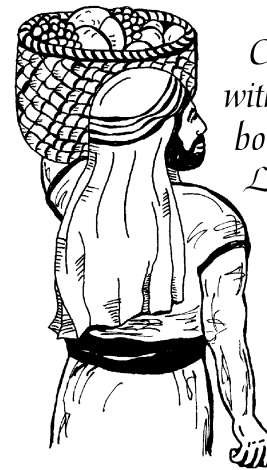

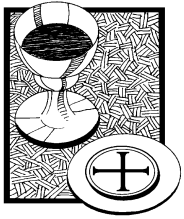

It's a simple meal, shared in common, to remind ourselves that Lent is a communal as well as a personal journey of faith. A free will offering may be given, if you wish, and it will be donated to the poor.

Moving away from food, I am happy to report that there have been positive comments made, as well as helpful suggestions offered, in regard to our Parish website. 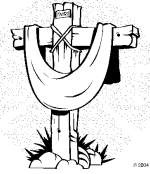
St. Vincent de Paul, St. Kevin's Conference
