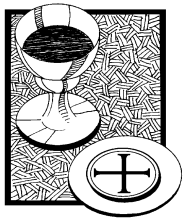



We meet at Our Lady of Peace Site in Capreol on **Tuesday night** this week, beginning at **7pm.** Members will have received their agendas by e-mail. All Parishioners are welcome to attend.



You will be hearing and reading a lot about “ARISE Together in Christ” in next few weeks, as we begin to prepare to form the small groups which are the heart of the ARISE process. It is in these small groups that Christ Jesus will be experienced through Holy Scripture, through the sharing with others, and through the prayer that will be expressed as a group. Those who have experienced small groups will know the positive impact they can have in our spiritual lives. Those who have not may be more unsure about them and, perhaps, a little timid to commit to the experience. There is, however, nothing strange about small groups or their dynamic, and they do help Christians to experience the presence of Christ in a deeper way.

Essentially, a small group consists of about 8 - 12 people, one of whom is the leader. She or he will direct the meeting, which lasts 90 minutes. It will consist of reading aloud a passage of Scripture, and then allowing the opportunity for group members to connect what they understand the passage to be saying to them as it relates to their own lives. It is all done in the context of prayer, and so is not so much a study group, and certainly not a context for debating points of view, so much as it is an opportunity to recognize how God is present in all the moments of our lives. The small groups teach us to be more aware of that presence.

ARISE comes to us as a gift from our Bishop who, after several years of discernment, came to realize that this is the direction God wishes our Diocese to take for the next few years. As your Pastor, I am inviting you to be open to this experience precisely as a gift for which we can be grateful, but for which also we much be open to receiving.

There is so much in our culture that whispers (sometimes shouts) to us: “God is absent” “God is dead” “God does not care” “God does not see”. It is difficult, as Christians, to live our faith in this context, let alone to grow deeper in it. ARISE can help. I encourage everyone to prayerfully consider this invitation that has been extended, to join a small group, and to participate fully in this wonderful opportunity to grow in faith.

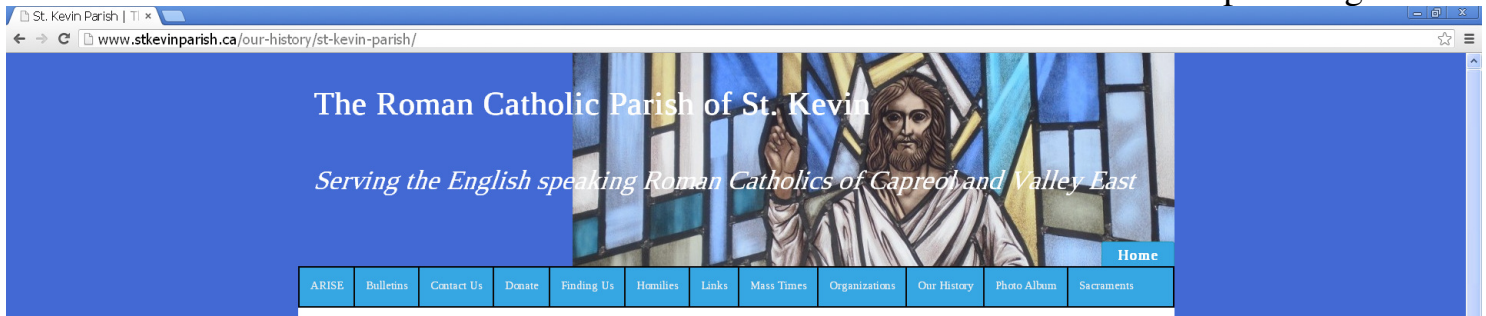
Please consider joining them.
