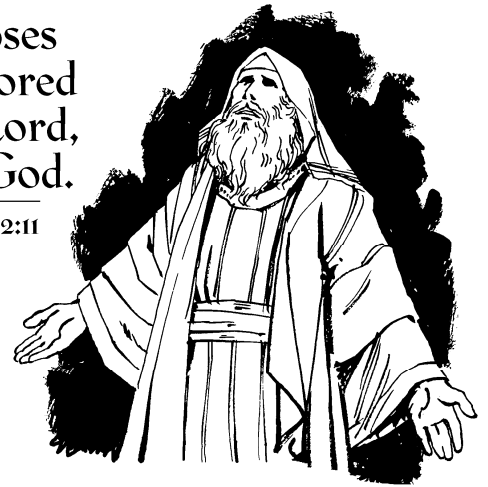

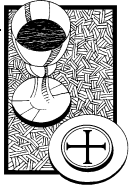

### **THEOLOGY ON TAP:**

This casual approach to faith discussion will return, beginning on Wednesday night this week at 7pm. Our topic of discussion will be:

#### **What about Creation? What about evolution?**

Everyone is welcome to join in this evening of discussion. Fr. Michael will contribute as one resource, but everyone is invited to participate. Then again, if you wish to simply sit and listen, that is fine too.

For planning purposes, we will have 4 sessions of T. on T.: September 14<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; October 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. Fr. There is no word on when we will have a second family in our community, and so we continue to wait.
