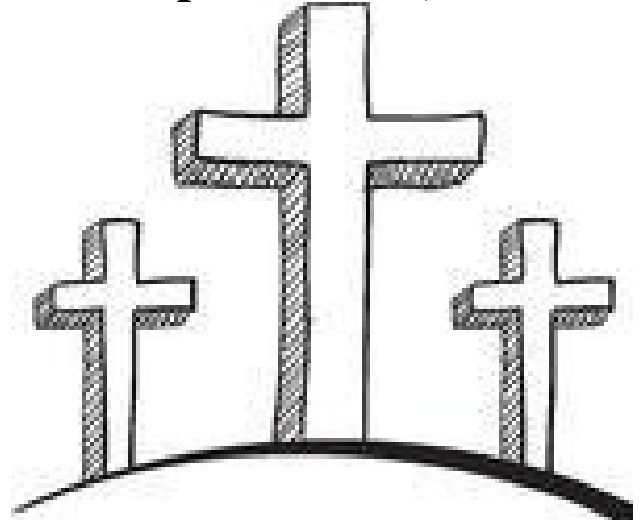

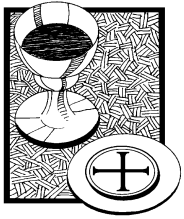

## **THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:**

Please remember that this Sacrament is available at any time for any Roman Catholic who is ill, upon request. The illness does not have to be one that may lead to death. The Sacrament brings the healing ministry of Jesus Christ into that part of our lives where we experience sickness of body, mind or spirit. It brings healing of various sorts – often bringing the sick person comfort and strength in the face of adversity and weakness. If you would like to be anointed with the Sacrament of the Sick, please just ask Fr. Michael. Like the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, this aspect of a priest's ministry is central to his whole reason for being here. A simple way to ask for this Sacrament is to make a personal request after any Mass. If you are homebound, a simple phone call or e-mail will do as well. The celebration of the Sacrament takes only a couple of minutes.
