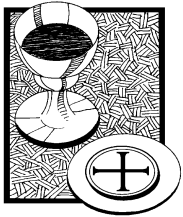

INFORMATION NIGHT:

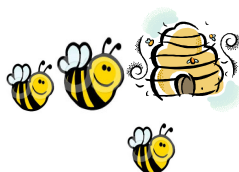
