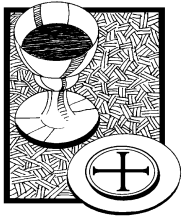

As I write this today (Wednesday), I'm just back from our Tuesday night Launch Mass for ARISE which took place at Christ the King Church, with Bishop Plouffe as the celebrant. Our Parish ARISE leader, Laurie Gagnon, received a lighted candle along with all the other Parish leaders in Sudbury, and was officially blessed by our Bishop as she continues to lead us in this process. All is well so far, and to date 80 Parishioners have signed up to participate in a small group. I'm very happy with this number and, as an aside, can say that we have more participants than many of the 'big Churches' in Sudbury. Well done!

One of the things I should clarify is for those who have not signed up for a small group – it's never too late! Even if you miss the train, you can hop on board at the next station. In fact, small group participants will be encouraged to invite at least one other person to join them for at least one small group session. It is a way to experience a small group session in order to see if it's something you might want to continue doing.

Over the next little while, those of you who have signed up for a small group will be contacted by your group facilitator, letting you know where and when your first meeting will begin. I am grateful to all our facilitators for stepping into these leadership roles. They have attended training for this task and I am overjoyed at their enthusiasm and commitment.
