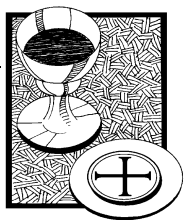

Sunday, Oct. 26th, 3:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Hope.

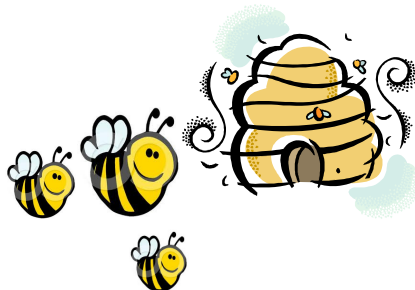
