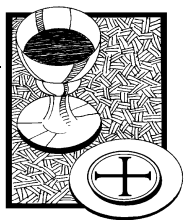

*Sunday, Oct. 26th, 3:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Hope.*

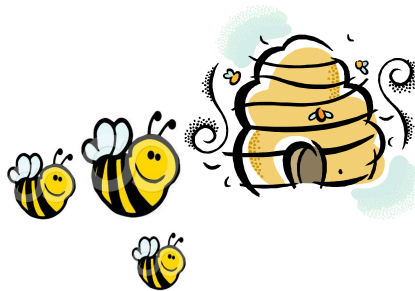

## **AN INVITATION TO ALL PARISHIONERS:**

At our Parish Leadership Team meeting on September 30<sup>th</sup>, we decided it was time to better define our mandate and the means through which we might fulfill it.

Since there are innumerable ways by which we might define our goals and set our agenda, we decided to consider the options open to us and choose the one that we felt would be most appropriate in our situation (multiple communities in a large region, two distinct worship sites, English minority, etc.).

This will involve an open “brainstorming session” to which ALL Parishioners are invited. If you want to be a part of the process by which your Parish Council (PLT) is re-formed, this is your opportunity.

We will meet to do this on Friday, October 24<sup>th</sup> in the Board Room at our St. Kevin’s Site, beginning at 4pm. Dinner (pizza) will be provided for everyone who participates.
