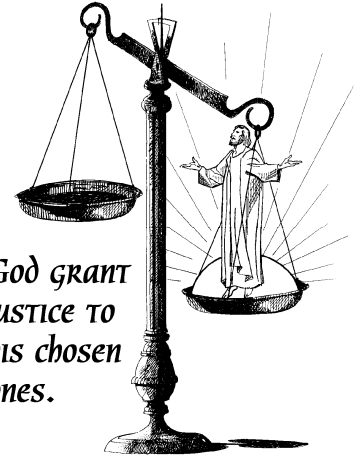

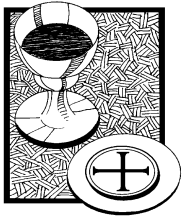

The Catholic Organization for Life and Family (COLF) is a service which promotes respect for human life and dignity, and the essential role of the family in our society. It is co-sponsored by the Canadian Catholic Bishops, and the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council. You will be familiar with it through some of the publications it provides, as I see a number of these stored in our parish office – leftovers from those made available at one time or another. Their publications are quite well done and address important issues in a very helpful way. I have always made them available to parishioners as they are produced.

Just now, two more publications have been made available. The first, **“As a Family, Choose Life: Choose Jesus Christ – A Christian Reflection on the New Age”** identifies some of the spiritual traps that prevent many people from developing an intimate personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The second, **“Bullying: A Plague to Combat Together”**, suggests solutions to a problem that has touched all of us in one way or another. With these, there are now 21 publications available from COLF, addressing many contemporary and challenging issues.

Having reviewed most of the publications, including these newest ones, I am impressed by them and I believe they can be helpful, especially if you are faced with the specific challenges they address. I’m also wary, however, about ordering a bunch and having them sit unused and, eventually, stored away in the Parish office. So, I’m inviting anyone who is interested in any of their publications, including the 2 newest ones, to simply let me know. I’ll gladly order them for you – and no charge. If you want to see a complete listing of their 21 publications, you can do so on their website at www.colf.ca – you can even download the documents from there if you wish, although it’s always nice to have a hard copy in your hands.

And on a totally different note, please continue to keep me in your good prayers this week, as I most certainly am keeping you in mine, while I’m on retreat. The director is Fr. Philip Chircop, and it is taking place at the Motherhouse of the Sisters of St. Joseph in North Bay. I am grateful to Monsignor Caruso who is celebrating our Masses this weekend, in order to allow me to experience this time with the Lord.
