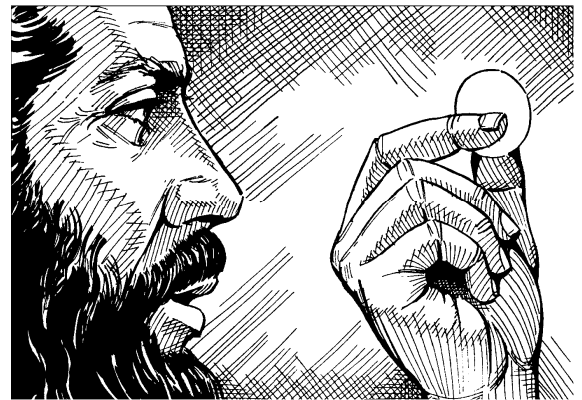

## **AN INVITATION TO ALL PARISHIONERS:**

At our Parish Leadership Team meeting on September 30<sup>th</sup>, we decided it was time to better define our mandate and the means through which we might fulfill it.

## **SOUND SYSTEM AT ST. KEVIN’S SITE:**

At the time of publishing this bulletin, we are still in the process of working out the bugs in our new sound system at our St. Kevin’s Site. The new wiring and new speakers have all been completed. However, the new sound board was installed, and then had to be uninstalled with a temporary one put in its place. The “final” sound board is still pending, so your patience is appreciated as we make use of the temporary one.



## **CHRISTMAS CARDS:**

For those who are interested, Fr. Michael has 100 mixed packages of Christmas cards (packages of 10) available for sale in the hall of our St. Kevin’s Site. One of the packages is open so that you can see what the individual cards look like. Please don’t open any others – they are all the same.

The cost to purchase them is \$10/pack. This is an honour system – there is a cash box there to leave your money. 100% of your purchase will be given to the Pregnancy Center in Sudbury to support their fine work, so that the deeper meaning of Christmas may be amplified through your greeting cards this year.
