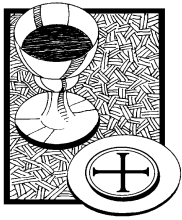



PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL:

As previously indicated, following the 2 open sessions held in the Parish last fall, a decision was made to replace the Parish Leadership Team with a new consultative body, called the Parish Pastoral Council. This new body will assist the Pastor in meeting the pastoral needs of our Parish community.

Membership will be comprised of between 8 – 12 members, with equal representation from both worship sites. Currently, there are 6 members:

St. Kevin's Site: Sue Godin, Gord Jenkinson and Aline Radey.

OL Peace Site: Bert D'Appolonia, Marilyn Paul and Jeannette Rainville.

We are now seeking interested Parishioners from both Sites to serve on the new PPC. If you are interested, or know of someone who is, you are invited to fill out and return the nomination form found in today's bulletin (also on our web page). If more than 3 nominations are received for either worship site, then an election will be held at that site.

Some of the issues which the Pastoral Council will need to address early on relate to its own structure: length of terms, format and frequency of meetings, terms of reference, etc. The members will also need to address some of the unresolved issues that were raised during the fall open meetings: Parish communication, unity between the worship sites, possible increase in socials and/or other committee work. Parishioners interested in being in on the 'ground floor' of these discussions should consider becoming a Parish Pastoral Council member.
