Our new Bishop is asking all Parishes to adopt some new security measures surrounding the way we handle money in our buildings. Part of this new security will impact those who take up the Sunday collections in our Churches. So, with that in mind, Fr. Michael is asking all those who are involved in taking up collections to meet with him following each one of our weekend Masses. There is a bit of training involved, but it should not take too long. **The weekend for this training will be December 10th/11th.** On that weekend (next weekend), ushers are asked simply to stay after Mass for a bit longer to meet with Fr. Michael and to learn what our new procedures for the entire Diocese will be.
