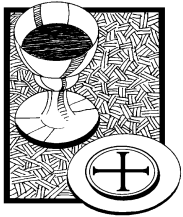

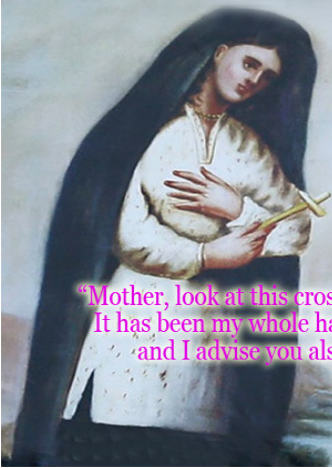

YEAR OF FAITH CELEBRATION:

On that day, Bishop Jean-Louis Plouffe will be the celebrant at our 5pm Parish Mass.

Following this, there will be a dinner hosted in our Parish Hall in Capreol –
Our Lady of Peace Site – during which we will gather to celebrate our faith
over a meal with good company.

Tickets for the dinner will be available in April.

The Rector of the Seminary I attended once reminded us that anything worth doing, is worth doing poorly. He wasn't encouraging sloppy work or poor effort; rather, he was reminding us that although we aim for perfection, it is never achieved on this side of paradise. And, in striving for perfection, it sometimes happens that we become paralyzed by our realization of its impossibility, and then nothing gets done. And so, term papers cannot be researched ad infinitum, as they must be handed in on a specific date. So, research as much as possible, then write, submit, and move on. Good advice, that was, and still is.

It reminds me of a comment Pope Francis made regarding the work of the Church. It can happen, he remarked, that our work in the world is so marked by fear of doing it wrong that we insulate ourselves in the comfort of our worship sites, offices and homes and fail to do any of the work in the world that Christ requires. In that situation, he warned, the Church no longer proclaims the Gospel, the purpose for which it exists, but becomes inward looking and interested only in its own existence for itself. He continued that he would much rather see the Church take the risk of making mistakes in the pursuit of evangelization, than take the safe road of doing nothing and becoming complacent and irrelevant.

This Easter Day, we proclaim Christ risen. It is a joyful proclamation meant for the entire world, and it is our mission to make that proclamation wherever it is we find ourselves. Yes, we pray. Yes, we study and strive to know the teachings. Yes, we worship God and allow ourselves to be strengthened through the Sacraments. But then we must act. This is the challenge of the Gospel we have received as we strive to give it flesh in our world.

If we wait for the perfect time, the perfect opportunity, the perfect weather, the perfect words or the perfect emotions, we likely will never act. The Gospel message is certainly worth knowing, and so making it known to others, even if we do it poorly, is still worth doing. Let's do it today.

ADOPT AN UNBORN CHILD:

Once again, everyone is invited to adopt an unborn child for this year. It is an idea initiated by Bishop Fulton Sheen and in response to the abortion holocaust underway in our land.

Pink (for girls) and blue (for boys) forms are available at the entrance of both Worship Sites. Please take it home and pray about it, before choosing a name for your baby. Write the name of your child, and your name too, on the right hand portion of the form, cut it off, and leave it in the crib in the entranceway to the Church.

Keep the left hand portion with your child's name and the prayer which you will commit to praying each day for your child.

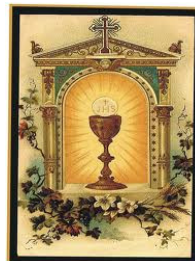
On the Feast of the Holy Innocents, Mass will be celebrated for all these children.

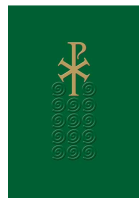

Based on the current rate of book donations, we expect the last hymnal to be donated on or before the last day of June.

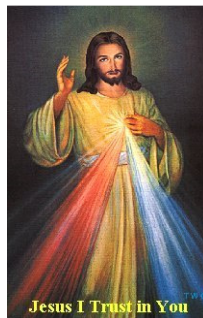


ENTER INTO RECONCILIATION AND HOLY EUCHARIST:
