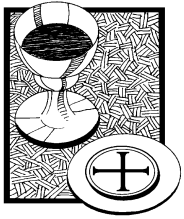

As everyone likely knows, with various decorations adorning many front lawns and a plethora of treats for sale in so many stores, this week marks the celebration of All Hallows Eve, itself the Vigil for the celebration of All Saints on Friday. That celebration, always held in our Church Universal on November 1st, marks the beginning of the month during which we pray in a particular way for those who have died (All Souls Day is celebrated on Saturday).

It may be appropriate, then, to speak anew of our Parish “In Memoriam” Book, soon to be introduced, as a means to remember those who have died and to pray for them. I made mention of this Book earlier this year, and draw attention to it now, as we hope to launch it in January. The “In Memoriam” cards have been drafted, and I hope to have the final approval of our Parish Leadership Team at our next meeting on November 19th to proceed with having them printed. Once available, you may use these cards to enrol the name(s) of deceased family members and friends in our “In Memoriam” Book. The book will be placed in the respective entranceways of our two worship sites, and during the month of November each year, it will be placed in front of the Altar, where all those enrolled will be remembered at all our Masses. It will be a tangible presence, for us, of those who have gone before us and for whom we continue to pray.

Historically, All Saints Day was established as a common day of celebration for those Christians who had been martyred and, thereby, had given the perfect witness to Jesus Christ - with their very lives. It is no small thing that the age of martyrs has returned to our Church with a vengeance, as the fires of persecution blaze around the world. While relatively safe from that level of persecution, at least for now, in Canada, we might pause to ask ourselves if we are ready to give that witness, should it ever be asked of us.

Of course, martyrdom calls forth a special grace from God. So too, though, does the daily witness we are called to give through our words, thoughts and actions. While praying this month for those who have died, may we walk in that grace, and so live our lives in faithfulness to our Baptismal promises so as to prepare ourselves to enter fully into the company of all the saints.

On **Tuesday October 29th**, the staff and students at Bishop Alexander Carter Catholic Secondary School will be participating in our 1st Annual fundraising memorial walk in memory of Mackenzie Rooney. Mackenzie was a student at Bishop Alexander Carter and a girl who loved life, was always smiling and very creative. Her life was cut too short in a tragic ATV accident in August 2012. Our walk on October 29th is an opportunity to remember Mackenzie and raise money for her scholarship fund and to support other activities within the school she enjoyed participating in. Our goal is to raise \$20,000. Money raised will be going towards a scholarship fund in her name and the sponsoring of activities in the school that she enjoyed.
