

Each month, 15% of this total is sent to our Bishop in order to run the Diocese. This 'tax' is known as the Diocesan Administration Expense, or DAE, and is based on the average of last year's donations.

HUMANITARIAN AID TO HAITI:

For those who wish to donate towards assisting the victims of hurricane Matthew in Haiti, Bishop Marcel has provided two options within the local Church.

The first option is to donate online through Development and Peace (official aid organization of the Church in Canada). To do this, go to their website at www.devp.org and click on "Haiti Emergency — Give Now". An official tax receipt will be issued immediately by e-mail.

The second option is to donate through the collection basket on October 30th (next weekend). **This will replace the Bishop's Annual Appeal scheduled for November 13th.** To do this, please use the Bishop's Annual Appeal envelope from Nov. 13th on October 30th instead. This money will be forwarded to the Diocese, who in turn will forward it to Development and Peace. A tax receipt in this case will be issued by the Parish.

NO WEEKDAY MASSES:



Catholics Celebrate Across Canada

The Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace (D&P) will be celebrating its 50th
Anniversary in 2017. To commemorate 50 years of solidarity work with countries of the Global South,
DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE has launched the stitching of a 'Solidarity Quilt' that is travelling the country
from West to East (British Columbia to Ontario) and from East to West (Newfoundland to Quebec). The
nation-wide pilgrimage was launched on Ash Wednesday, February 10, 2016 with the first squares of the quilt
stitched in St. John's, Newfoundland and in Victoria, British Columbia. Since then each Canadian diocese has
been invited to add a square to the quilt as it passes through. All are invited to attend a special Pilgrimage
Mass which will be celebrated by Bishop Marcel Damphousse, on Sunday November 6 at 11:00 AM at Ste.
Anne de Pins Church in Sudbury, when the two quilt pieces from the Anglophone and Francophone D&P
Diocesan Councils of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie will be added to the growing quilt. When the patches
complete their pilgrimage just before Easter of 2017, they will be sewn together to create a huge quilt; a work of
human hands that will represent the solidarity that has been lived by Canadians and people of the Global South
throughout the 50 year history of DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE.
