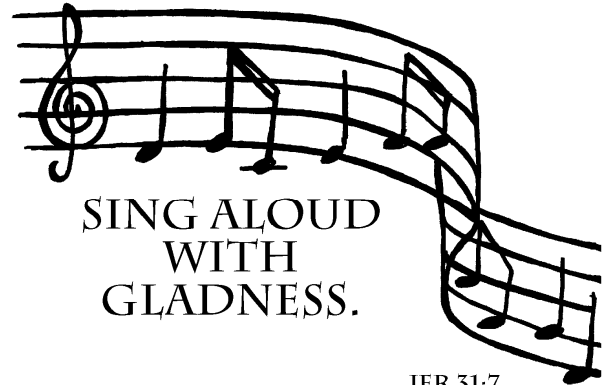

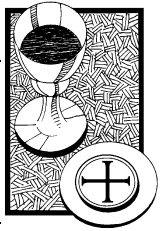

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP

This past week, a large number of Parishioners attended a meeting held at Trinity United Church in Capreol. They joined the members of that congregation and some from St. Alban's Anglican Church in moving forward with the refugee sponsorship process. Among other things, in the midst of some information gathering and discussion, an executive committee was formed with representatives from all our Churches. A family of nine from Syria (now in Lebanon) was chosen from a number of possibilities. Since this is very early in the process, it does not mean that we will be successful in bringing this particular family to Capreol, or that we will even be accepted by the government as a sponsoring group. For that reason, we'll keep the details of the family quiet for now. This corner of the bulletin will, however, be run each week with a view to keeping everyone "in the loop" about our progress.
