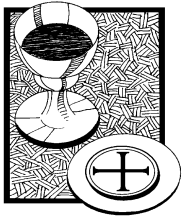



Remembrance Day:

Although we don't mark Remembrance Day until November 11th, Fr. Michael will be at Immaculate Conception School on Wednesday this week to celebrate a Remembrance Liturgy with the students there. During the month of November, in a particular way we remember all who have died, and in this period of time during mid-November, we remember the anguish of war as we yearn and pray and work for peace.



This weekend, Daylight Saving Time ends. More precisely, it ends at 2:00 am on Sunday, November 3rd, at which time you are invited to jump out of bed to adjust your clocks to read 1:00 am. Of course, another option is to anticipate the moment and do it before you go to bed. However you do it, it means we move our clocks back one hour, thereby recapturing those 60 minutes lost on March 10, which was 342,720 minutes ago. Sometimes, you have to travel far to recapture what you have lost.

Indeed, we have all travelled quite far in those 342,720 minutes. Hopefully, we can say that we have grown and matured gracefully. Hopefully we can also say we have enriched our lives through our relationships with loved ones, worked on healing our wounds and divisions, and deepened our love for God.

Of course, in God, there is no time. All is present to God as now. I try not to think about that too terribly long, as it hurts my brain. But it does make sense to think of it through my own "now". After all, that is all I have. The past is gone and the future is not yet. It is only the "holy now", also expressed as "the precious present" which meets me and invites me to be more wholly the one God has made.

By my reckoning, we have only 181,440 minutes ahead of us until we "Spring ahead" into Daylight Savings Time once again. I hope, and I pray, that those minutes, and all the seconds which compose them, are filled with the experience of God's Presence, for He fills all places and is present in all things, a thousand years being just a moment and each moment being a special gift from God to you and I in which we come to know that precious love.
