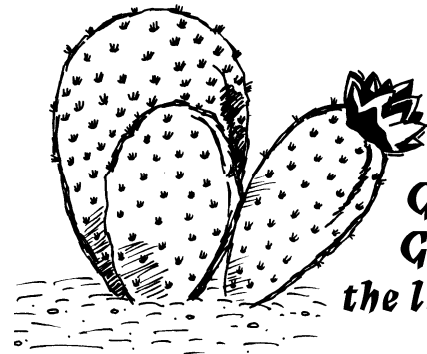

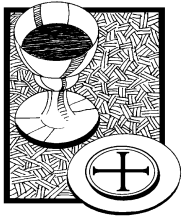

Those preparing to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation are reminded of our meeting/rehearsal on **Thursday night this week, beginning at 6pm.**



On Monday this week - Remembrance Day – we pause in silence to pay our respects to those who have sacrificed themselves in the cause for peace. It is a worthy tradition our culture has embraced, flowing as it does from the horror of conflict that engulfed our world so often in the last century, and the deep desire for peace which originates in God’s plan for humanity. As Pope Pius XII said: “nothing is lost by peace; everything is lost by war”.

In this context, it is opportune to recall that peace is not simply the absence of conflict, but rather an ordering of our lives and of society on the basis of God’s love in which image and likeness we have been created. This is a daily task for each of us, for when sin is at work in our lives (and when is it not?), then we are seeking after our own good and advantage, rather than living our lives in the grace of God which calls us to live as His children – seeking the good and advantage of the other.

We are well aware of the conflicts which have demanded of our young soldiers a sacrifice of blood and suffering. We rightly give honor to those who responded so courageously to the call to arms to defend the fundamental rights of those who were threatened. Less willing are we (at times, anyway), of making those courageous decisions every day that would see love conquer sin in our lives, such that no recourse to arms would ever prove necessary.

The seeds of war are planted many generations before a single shot is fired: the words, gestures and actions of men, women and children, rooted in jealousy, greed and anger, spoken and acted out a million times every day.

Remembrance Day is not just a time to remember the necessary call to arms due to such failure. No. It is also a time to remember that the seeds of peace are planted in every generation, when men, women and children speak words and actions of compassion and love, forgiveness and forbearance, unity and patience, gentleness and hope. My prayer is that each one of us commit ourselves anew to be people of peace each day, so that future generations will reap the harvest of that peace.

No Mass Wednesday:

There will be no Mass on Wednesday morning this week, as Fr. Michael will be attending an Ontario wide Conference on Funerals, which is being held in Sudbury on Tuesday and Wednesday. Bishop Plouffe will be celebrating the Conference Mass at 5pm at Christ the King Church on that day (Wednesday), if anyone is interested in attending that celebration.

Nine years ago, during the Centennial Year of our Diocese, Bishop Plouffe had hoped to have published a history book of our Diocese. It's a little late, but the project has now come to fruition, and copies of this beautiful coffee table book, full of pictures, are now available for purchase. The price is \$30.00/book.

The actual date of availability is March of 2014, but they are only publishing enough copies ("limited printing") to fill pre-orders. The books will not be available for purchase afterwards.
