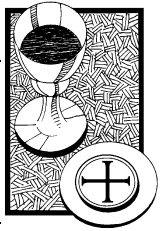

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

The Capreol-Valley Refugee Sponsorship Committee continues to make progress in our efforts to sponsor a family of refugees in our community. Donation envelopes, as previously announced, are available at the entranceway of both our worship sites. Your generosity is appreciated.

Currently, the necessary paperwork is being prepared to show to the government that we have a viable plan in place to sponsor and support a family for a minimum of one year. Your donations are critical in allowing us to show that we have the financial means necessary to allow this support. At the same time, we are hoping to finalize the contract necessary with our Parish/Diocese that will guarantee the use of the Rectory in Capreol for as long as is necessary for our family to become established.

Although we still do not know when our family might arrive, we have heard that it may be sooner than originally anticipated – perhaps even within 2 – 4 months. So, there is a lot of preparation work going on as we seek to be ready to accept this family no matter when they arrive.

As more details emerge, we will announce in this space how others may help in this preparation. For now, the biggest help needed is financial, so please do be generous.
