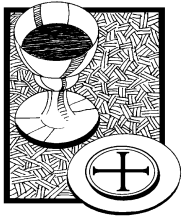



RECONCILIATION:

Please keep in your prayers those of our Parish who will be celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time this coming Saturday morning. Since this is a time of celebration particular to them, we would ask that other parishioners refrain from coming to Confession this day, and seek out the Sacrament, if needed, at another time.

HOLY HOUR:

Our monthly Holy Hour of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, concluding with Benediction, at Our Lady of Peace Worship Site, will be on **Thursday** morning this week, following the morning Mass.



With the terrible destruction wrought by Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippine Islands, and the corresponding human suffering of which we are becoming more aware, there is a deep desire on the part of many to reach out to our brothers and sisters in need with assistance over and beyond the prayers we already offer for them.

I have not yet heard of an official effort by our Diocese to that end, and so am offering a Parish based means, for those who wish, by which we can funnel financial aid through organizations in a position to help in practical ways.

And so, if you wish to make a financial donation to assist those suffering in the Philippines, you may do so by using your own envelope marked "Philippines". Cheques should still be made out to "St. Kevin Parish", and we will issue the receipt for income tax purposes. **Please note: our Parish will match any donations made, dollar for dollar, between now and the 1st Sunday of Advent.** The Canadian government will also match all donations made dollar for dollar, which means your dollar will become 4 dollars. In addition to our prayers, we hope that these offerings will help to bring some consolation and stability to those many lives suffering upheaval. You were very generous in your assistance to our brothers and sisters in Attawapiskat last year, in Haiti following the devastating earthquake of 2010, and in Indonesia following the tsunami that swept through in 2004. I hope we can continue to show our love and support to those in need, each according to their means.

NEW HYMNALS:

Thanks to your generous donations, we have been able to purchase permanent hymnals for our 2 worship sites, to replace the disposable ones we have been purchasing each year, for many years. We will begin using the new Journey Songs Hymnal on the first day of year - on Sunday, December 1st, two weeks hence. When we do, please note the following protocol which we will use; it's already our practice at Our Lady of Peace, but will be new for St. Kevin:

The hymn books will not be in the pews; rather, they will be left in a cart which will be placed near the main entranceway. We would ask that you take a hymn book from the cart when you enter the Church, and then return it to the cart when you leave. Your cooperation in this is very much appreciated.

Please note the Parish office will be open only Tuesday morning and all day Wednesday next week (closed Thursday and Friday).



History Book of Our Diocese:

Nine years ago, during the Centennial Year of our Diocese, Bishop Plouffe had hoped to have published a history book of our Diocese. It's a little late, but the project has now come to fruition, and copies of this beautiful coffee table book, full of pictures, are now **available for purchase. The price is \$30.00/book.**

The actual date of availability is March of 2014, **but they are only publishing enough copies ("limited printing") to fill pre-orders. The books will not be available for purchase afterwards.**

For this reason, we are asking anyone who is interested in purchasing a history book to pre-pay (cheques made out to St. Kevin Parish) **before the end of November. It will be too late after that date.**

All Parishes, including St. Kevin and Our Lady of Peace, have one page dedicated to them. It is being professionally done, and is sure to please everyone.

If you have any questions about this project, please speak to Trudy in the office, or to Fr. Michael. Trudy was able to pre-view a draft copy of the book and was thoroughly impressed by it.

ADVENT RECONCILIATION:

This year, we will celebrate an Advent Reconciliation Service in our Parish, at our St. Kevin Worship Site, beginning at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, December 17th. The form of this celebration may be a little different from what some are accustomed to, but will be done in a manner which allows us to celebrate God's love and grace in our lives, while humbly asking forgiveness for our sins.

As a means of preparation for this celebration (since it's only 4 weeks away), everyone is invited to pray about and ponder 2 words. The first is a word of thanks to God for a particular grace, favor, strength or gift. Our primary reality before God is, after all, that of being blessed.

The second word is a word of sorrow for a failure, a sin or a weakness to which we have succumbed. Our reality before God also includes our need to be forgiven.

At our Reconciliation service, each one of us will be invited to speak first your word of thanks, and then your word of sorrow, to Fr. Michael, who will then pray the words of absolution over you. Two words. Everyone will be invited to remain until all have been forgiven, as this service should last no more than one hour.

OLP CWL BAZAAR:

We are grateful to the CWL of Capreol who, after having run another very successful Bazaar, have **donated** half their proceeds to our Parish, in the amount of **\$1,179.15**. That is **in addition to** the money they raised through the raffles, also earmarked for the Church, in the amount of **\$2,766.50**.
