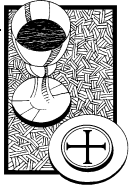

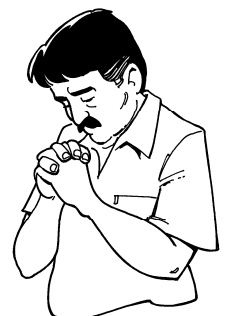

## **Greater Sudbury Regional Mass at Holy Redeemer -Tuesday, Jan. 24th at 4:15 PM**

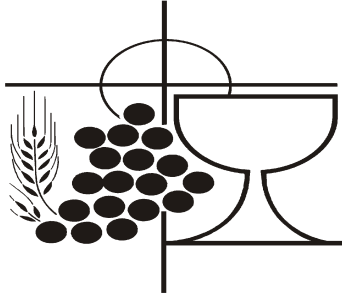
On Jan 24th the priests and deacons of our region will gather for a meeting in the afternoon at Holy Redeemer Church.
