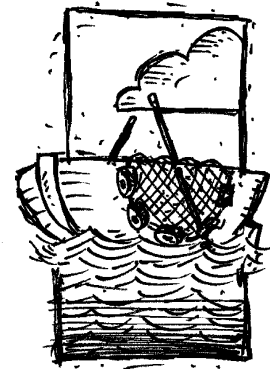

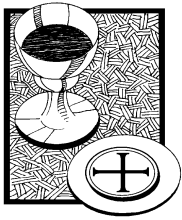

## **PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL – SECOND NOTICE:**

As previously indicated, following the 2 open sessions held in the Parish last fall, a decision was made to replace the Parish Leadership Team with a new consultative body, called the Parish Pastoral Council. This new body will assist the Pastor in meeting the pastoral needs of our Parish community.

Membership will be comprised of between 8 – 12 members, with equal representation from both worship sites. Currently, there are 6 members:

St. Kevin's Site: Sue Godin, Gord Jenkinson and Aline Radey.  
OL Peace Site: Bert D'Appolonia, Marilyn Paul and Jeannette Rainville.

We are now seeking interested Parishioners from both Sites to serve on the new PPC. If you are interested, or know of someone who is, you are invited to fill out and return the nomination form found in today's bulletin (also on our web page). If more than 3 nominations are received for either worship site, then an election will be held at that site.

Some of the issues which the Pastoral Council will need to address early on relate to its own structure: length of terms, format and frequency of meetings, terms of reference, etc. The members will also need to address some of the unresolved issues that were raised during the fall open meetings: Parish communication, unity between the worship sites, possible increase in socials and/or other committee work. Parishioners interested in being in on the 'ground floor' of these discussions should consider becoming a Parish Pastoral Council member.

## **OTTAWA MARCH FOR LIFE:**

A few parishioners have asked if we might, as a parish, organize an overnight trip to Ottawa to participate in the Annual March for Life. We did this in 2012, with 10 participants. In order to gauge the interest in this activity, and to plan the possible booking of hotel rooms, we are asking anyone who is interested to let Fr. Michael know. Our tentative plan would be to leave on Wednesday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, and to arrive in Ottawa in time to participate in the Candle Light Vigil at the Human Rights Monument that evening. On Thursday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, we would participate in the Mass at one of the Cathedrals, and then the March itself. Following the March for Life, we would drive home. For planning purposes, you can anticipate a cost of about \$110 (shared hotel room plus gas), plus the cost of your meals. Hotels fill quickly in Ottawa in May, so please make your intentions known to Fr. Michael before Lent begins (3 weeks from now).

### **NEW POLICY IN DIOCESE FOR STIPENDS:**

Bishop Plouffe has announced a few changes concerning the offerings made for various Sacraments in our Diocese. Beginning February 2<sup>nd</sup>, a donation of \$50 is normative for all Baptisms, \$275 for all weddings and funerals, and \$15 for all Mass requests. In addition to these changes, all of those donations will now be considered eligible for tax receipts. As before, consideration will be given to those unable to afford these donations, and nobody will be refused a celebration due to their inability to pay.
