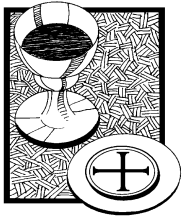



This week, on April 17<sup>th</sup>, Fr. Gerry Sullivan celebrates 59 years of Priesthood. Congratulations Fr. Gerry! Fr. Gerry, now residing in Capreol, has served both Our Lady of Peace Parish and St. Kevin's Parish as Parish Priest.

As always, commitment, perseverance and faithfulness, along with joy, are the great signs we look to when we celebrate any anniversary – be it ordination, marriage or religious profession – as these events witness for us the greatness of the human spirit in reaching out and fulfilling the longing for something that is lasting. We are lifted up by those who show us the possibility of that for which each of us strives, even as we are disappointed by the reality of failures – our own and other's. At times, it seems, there are so many examples of the latter, that we begin to think of brokenness as normative. It is not. We should always protect ourselves from thinking that it is, and especially when we fall into its grasp.

The joy we experience in celebrating an anniversary is the joy of knowing God Who is present in our lives not as One Who is temporary, or fragmented, or partial, but as One Who is present forever, wholly, and complete. We stand in the presence of God Who is present in all places and fills all things, but we actually come to know that presence in the concrete people and situations of our lives. Hence, anniversaries show us God's faithfulness and remind us of that of which we often are forgetful – that God never forgets us.

Always, then, it is good to celebrate these events. This is a truth of which I need constantly to remind myself, whenever I am tempted to downplay the importance of significant milestones in my own life. I need to realize that such milestones, and their celebrations, are not mine alone, but belong to everyone who longs to experience both human and divine faithfulness. We all need to experience the joy of 'merely' human events, for they point to a joy that finds its origin in God. It is precisely in the experience of joy that we know God is present. A dour believer does not know God's presence, for God is always a source of life and of joy.

Thank you, Fr. Gerry, for your faithfulness and love. Your celebration this week is our celebration too, and so we rejoice with you and continue to pray for you, as you do for us.

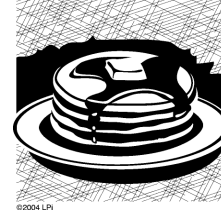

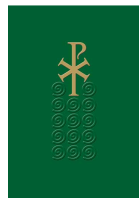

### **ENTER INTO RECONCILIATION AND HOLY EUCHARIST:**

Registration forms are available from Fr. Michael, following any weekend Mass, for those wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation and to begin weekly reception of Holy Communion. The normal minimum age for those wishing to begin this process is eight. So, if your child will be eight years of age or older by the end of this year, and you wish to practice your Catholic faith with them, please see Fr. Michael in order to begin that process.



### **MARCH FOR LIFE:**

Last year, a group of Parishioners attended the March for Life Rally with Fr. Michael in Ottawa (this year on May 9th). In order to ensure a block of hotel rooms at a decent price, expressions of interest were invited as early as January. This year, nobody seemed to express an interest, and so Fr. Michael planned on attending alone.
