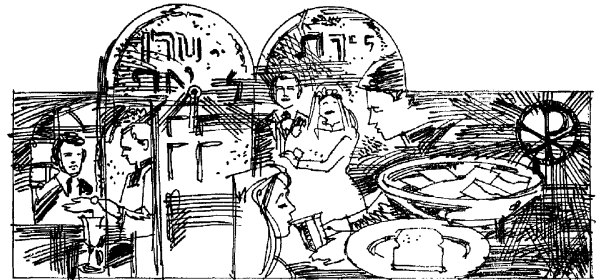

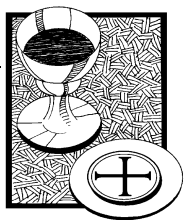

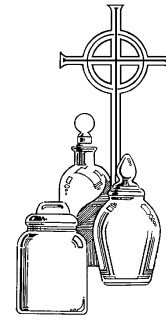


Memorial Easter Flowers

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION:

Registration forms are now available for anyone who wishes to register their child for the preparation programs leading to the celebration of Reconciliation (Confession/Penance) this fall, and then the reception of Holy Eucharist the following spring.

These preparation programs are open to anyone who will be 8 years of age or older by the end of this year. Exceptions may be made for those who are younger. There is no “maximum” age – all are welcome. This program can be used also by those who wish their child to enter into the Catholic Church (ie. previously Baptized into another Christian Church denomination).

Registration forms are available from Fr. Michael following any Mass at either one of our worship sites. Please ask him for one if you wish your child to be a part of this process, leading to the celebration of both of these Sacraments.

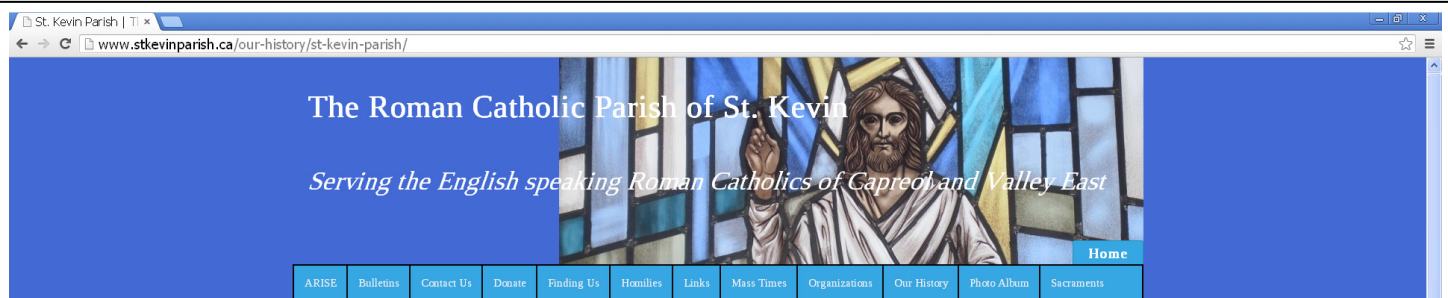


Once again, the Society's Food Bank is requesting specific items during each week of Lent. This week the appeal is for
