NEW POLICY IN DIOCESE FOR STIPENDS:

Bishop Plouffe has announced a few changes concerning the offerings made for various Sacraments in our Diocese. Beginning February 2nd, a donation of \$50 is normative for all Baptisms, \$275 for all weddings and funerals, and \$15 for all Mass requests. In addition to these changes, all of those donations will now be considered eligible for tax receipts. As before, consideration will be given to those unable to afford these donations, and nobody will be refused a celebration due to their inability to pay. The donations connected to Weddings and Funerals do not include the cost of the musician(s) or funeral luncheons (which costs are not eligible for tax receipts).
