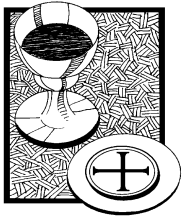

ANNIVERSARY DINNER:

Tickets for our June 1st Year of Faith Anniversary dinner are now available for purchase. They may be purchased through the Parish office during regular hours, and are also available both before and after all weekend Masses at both our Worship Sites. Tickets will be available for purchase for only the next 4 weeks (until May 19th) OR until all 200 tickets are sold. Please purchase your tickets early so that you will not be disappointed.

Most of us would acknowledge how difficult it is to find the motivation to exercise every day. There is a certain physical sluggishness that sets in when we do not, however, and that becomes a vicious circle, as that very sluggishness makes motivation even more difficult to discover. Some have the willpower to simply ‘do it’ every day, no matter what. Others, however, find it immensely helpful to use motivational strategies like joining a group or paying money to join a gym. It’s hard to ignore your jogging partner banging on your door at 6am, or the guilt factor in paying a large sum for an unused membership.

The spiritual life is much the same, as spiritual sluggishness takes hold of us when we do not actively seek the face of God every day and put aside the necessary prayer time every day to listen to His voice. And spiritual sluggishness begets the same results in the spiritual realm as physical sluggishness does in the physical realm – a disincentive to ‘get going’, laziness, getting out of shape, and eventually leading to malfunctioning and death.

Some have the willpower to enter into Communion with God, every day, no matter what. Others, however, find it immensely helpful to use motivational strategies like joining a group or becoming vested, through time and effort, in a structure which leads us closer to God. It’s hard to ignore your prayer partner or small group when they are expecting you and have put a fresh pot of coffee on for you, or the guilt factor in making a commitment which you fail to keep.

This, then, is some of the thinking behind our Parish ARISE process, which our Parish Arise Team is currently preparing to launch in our Parish, and in which we hope most of our Parishioners will become involved, beginning this Fall. We all struggle, in various ways, with spiritual sluggishness. We all can benefit enormously from small groups of like-minded Parishioners, who will support us in our desire to enter more deeply, daily, into Communion with God. The process is designed to provide participants with the incentive needed to ‘get going’ spiritually. As my post-marathon-injury-physiotherapist had on his wall: “a body at rest stays at rest; a body in motion stays in motion” – spiritually, we all need something to keep us in motion. My hope during this “Year of Faith” is that Arise will provide us with the incentive we need to reach that goal.

For those who wish to participate, you will be invited to take a baby bottle home and fill it with your loose change over the following 5 weeks. On Father’s Day, we will be asking you to return the filled bottles to the Church. All the money collected will be given to the Sudbury Pregnancy Centre, to support them in their excellent efforts in favour of life.
