However, conveying your questions or concerns to the Parish Office will remain the most effective way of communicating your needs and of receiving an appropriate response.

As before, anonymous communications are never accepted and will be discarded immediately, unread. There are a host of problems trying to respond to anything done 'in secret', and so our best practices approach is to ignore unsigned communications.

STONE SOUP SUPPER:

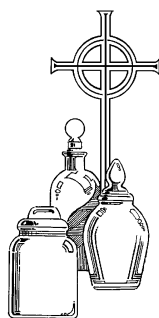

Delivery will be in early April.



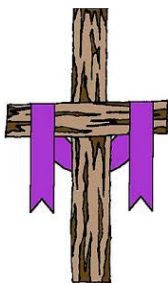
Chrism Mass 2015
