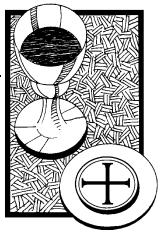

Our third annual ELEVATE Sudbury will take place on Saturday, May 28<sup>th</sup>. More details on that below.

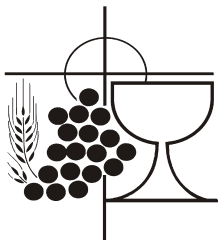
#### **ELEVATE:**
