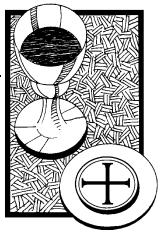

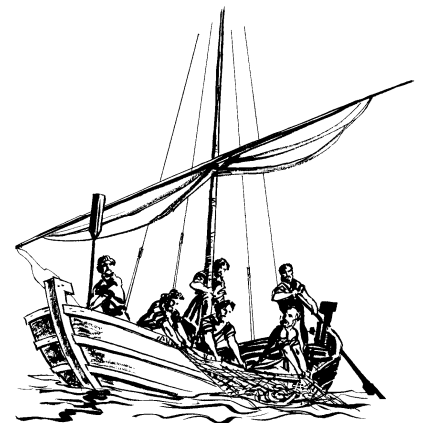

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

As previously announced, we have reached our fund raising goal – thank you to everyone who contributed. Your generosity has been overwhelming.

Funds now raised in the Parish will be used to offset the house expenses for which our Parish is responsible. So, for example, the **\$1,145.80** raised in Capreol through the Soup and Sandwich Sunday will be used to offset the cost of some of the house purchases that we made and some of the repairs that had to be done, as well as the ongoing cost of water, heat, electricity and maintenance.

As to the Alzahrán family, they continue to integrate into our community. The parents are on a waiting list for language school. In the meantime, we are relying on community volunteers with experience in teaching English as a second language. LIVING FAITH (final notice):

Please note that the currently available “Living Faith” books will no longer be provided by the Parish. The current book provides reflections up until the end of March. Before then, those who would like to continue receiving this resource are invited to subscribe directly, using the information provided at the back of the current book.

The reason for this change is primarily financial. It costs the Parish close to \$1,000 every year to provide this resource, and we find that the numbers using it vary widely from quarter to quarter, meaning some of that money is wasted when books go unused. Right now, at the end of January, there are still over 30 books available. By subscribing personally, Parishioners will be assured of receiving their copy directly, and nothing will be wasted.

Additionally, there are many other excellent resources available for daily reflections, both in print and online, and this may be an opportune time for some to explore the alternatives and discover something that is even more enriching to your spiritual life.

For those unsure of how to pay for something in US Funds, you have 2 options. One is to phone (toll free) and order your subscription using your credit card. It will be charged in US Funds. The other is to obtain a Money Order in US Funds from either the post office or your own financial institution and mail it in with your order as per the instructions in the book.
