

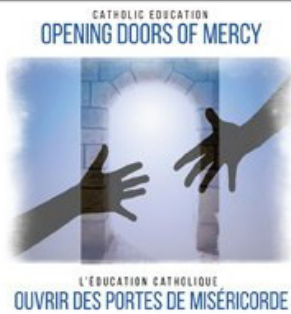

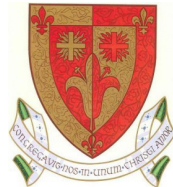

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

While we continue to support and help integrate the Alzahran family into our community, we are waiting to sponsor a second family in our community, this time in Val Caron. Following last month's meeting in our Parish Hall, 27 people from all the Christian Churches in our area committed themselves to helping with this project, with three agreeing to oversee the key task of integration once a new family arrives. The plan is for a small family (3 – 5) to be hosted at Sr. Frederica House, which will be donated by St. Vincent de Paul for one year for that purpose. Currently, there is a very long waiting period for sponsorship, and so we are in waiting mode. There is a possibility that an emergency situation will arise to which we can respond, but the current likelihood is that it will be a year or longer before a second family is designated for us.
