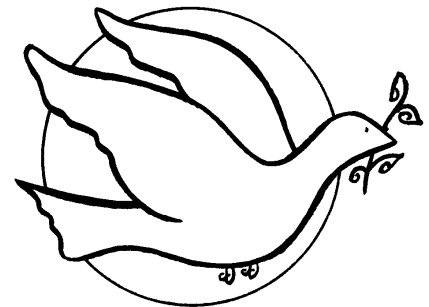

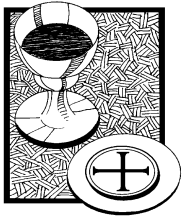



MARCH FOR LIFE:

The National March for Life takes place in Ottawa this week on Thursday. Fr. Michael will be attending, and so there will be no weekday Masses in the Parish on Thursday or Friday this week. In the wake of the sad reality in our broken world that female pre-born babies are killed simply because of their gender, the theme of this year's March is **“It's a girl' Should Not be a Death Sentence”**. Also in the wake of the evil brought to light in the murder trial of Dr. Kermit Gosnell, it is worth recalling the somber reality that nearly 2000 late term abortions are done every year in Canada, and that upwards of 10 – 20 of these babies are born alive, and subsequently left to die. This is the face of the abortion logic. For those unable to attend the March, your prayers would be appreciated.

Through prayer, we lift our hearts to God Who is always present to us. It is the means by which we become consciously present to His Presence. It is also the way we bring others into God's presence, for by our awareness of another's need, we can bring those needs to God. In a sense, we become a conduit of God's Presence to someone who may not know that Presence themselves.

In our parish, as in many others, we take this call to pray for others seriously, as it is an effective ministry of compassion and concern for our community. Through our Parish Prayer Ministry, many needs are offered to God in prayer every day. It works in this way: if you have a particular need – an illness, an upcoming surgery, a difficulty, a struggle – or you know someone else in such a state, you may call one of the persons listed on the front cover of our Parish bulletin. That begins a cascade of calls to everyone on the prayer line so that many people become involved in praying for that intention. The prayer itself is quite simple: some bring all the daily intentions to their regular daily prayer time and offer them to God. Others offer their day, in its entirety, to God on behalf of those on the prayer list. That, by the way, is a very effective prayer, as it intentionally places before God all the ups and downs of the day.

On Sunday, the second last intention is always offered for those on the prayer list. Like the prayer line itself, it is anonymous, in the sense that no names are exchanged and details are kept to a minimum – it is not a gossip line or a way to keep up with the news.

Anyone is welcome to join the prayer line. You can do so simply by contacting one of the coordinators listed and asking to be included. It is an effective way of remembering that the best prayer is not one that seeks our own intentions, but rather one that puts the needs of others first before God. Love is like that.



CELEBRATION!:

Next Sunday morning, following the 9:30 Mass, the Catholic Women's League will host a reception in honour of those in our Parish who have completed their year of prayer towards entering the Sacraments of Reconciliation and weekly Holy Eucharist. This reception is open to everyone, so please plan on staying for a cup of coffee or piece of cake in order to congratulate and encourage these young parishioners.

This year, 15 young people participated in our preparation process.
