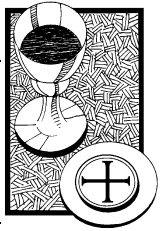

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

There has been a lot of action going on in this Community initiative in the past week or so. The key highlight is, we have been matched with “Family 436”, a family of nine. They were designated as “urgent” by the UN high commission. Now begins a lot of paperwork, for which we are grateful to Faye Moffat for taking on.

Our current information is that the process may move faster than anticipated. We don't know how fast, but we do know that we need to immediately embark upon fundraising and the establishment of our settlement plan.

So, we need to talk about money. That's really where the rubber hits the road - or in this case, where our love and concern for our neighbor becomes incarnate.

As previously indicated, our Bishop has ordered that **“parishes are not to provide any financial commitment, or obligations for refugees; no collections for parish sponsorship or participation in joint sponsorship is permitted.”**

Given that restriction, we need to be mindful that parishioners here are participating on their own initiative in the group called the “Capreol-Valley Refugee Sponsorship Committee”. So, donations may be made directly to this committee which has been established and which is able to issue receipts for income tax purposes.

If you wish to donate, you will find envelopes available for that purpose in the entranceway of each of our worship sites. You can send the donation to the address indicated on the envelope. If you wish, you may also drop the envelope in our own Sunday collection basket. These will be delivered to the Refugee Sponsorship Committee and the receipt will be issued by the United Church in Capreol.

Your generosity is always appreciated. In future columns, we will provide more information about who is on the executive committee and how you may become involved further, if you wish.
