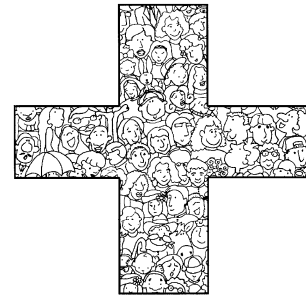

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL:

Our PPC met on May 6th and discussed the following pastoral issues:

(1) Parish initiatives post-Arise; (2) Re-evangelization of our community; and (3) Unity between our worship sites.

The following is a brief summary of the conclusions we reached.

- (1) It was felt to be unnecessary to repeat the parish survey that was done 3 years ago. It is obvious that whatever is done should be Scripture based. Some have already expressed a desire for 'something' to continue after Arise. Fr. Michael will speak to the Arise team about this, and will invite our Arise coordinator to our next meeting to help us formulate a plan of action.
- (2) No consensus was reached, and no concrete plan of action was proposed. Anecdotal sharing seems to indicate that one on one, personal invitations are always the most effective. We concluded that this issue is somewhat tied in with the first issue, and we will continue to give this some prayerful thought.
- (3) It was generally agreed that the process leading up to the closure of Our Lady of Peace Parish was seriously flawed, but also that this is now water under the bridge. Going forward, in addition to time being an effective healer, it was generally agreed that the more interaction between the parishioners from both sites takes place, the healthier will be our sense of unity. Fr. Michael agreed that any ministers mandated for one site are automatically mandated for the other, so that Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Servers, etc., can serve at both sites. There may be concerns expressed around some financial issues, so Fr. Michael will take this up with the Finance Committee, with a reminder being made to all Parishioners that they are always free to bring their financial concerns to their representatives on this committee.

Our next meeting date is scheduled for Tuesday, September 29th. Everyone is reminded that this information is also posted on our Parish Web Site.

EMERGENCY IN NEPAL:

Bishop Plouffe has indicated his desire to allow Parishioners to make donations through our Parishes to assist the people of Nepal following the devastating earthquake on April 24th. To that end, he suggests 2 options (both options would direct your donations to Development and Peace, so if you prefer donating to a different charity, please do so directly with them).

The first option is to donate directly to Development and Peace through their website: www.devp.org. The second option would be to donate through the Parish. To use the second option, please clearly indicate your donation is for Nepal on an envelope.

These monies must be received no later than **May 28th** in order that they can all be given through the Diocese at the same time, and matching funds received from our government.

Regardless of what you choose to do, please keep the people of this poverty stricken region in your good prayers.

FROM BISHOP PLOUFFE:

An indigenous celebration will be held on Saturday, May 23rd at Fielding Memorial Park. This event is a joint initiative between Indigenous and non-indigenous people of our Diocese. The celebration will begin with a sunrise ceremony at 5:30am, followed by an official welcome by the Bishop and a pancake breakfast at 8am. A teaching carousel will follow at 9am, and a healing circle at 11am. It will conclude with a pot luck lunch at 1:30pm. There is no charge for any of these activities. The Bishop writes: "I invite you to learn, through this event, the contributions of our indigenous peoples to life in our diocese and to experience their unique expressions of spirituality. It will be a pleasure to meet together to strengthen the ties which unite us."

Please note: Fr. Michael regrets that he will be unable to participate in either of these activities on May 23rd, as he will be active in another event previously planned many months prior.
