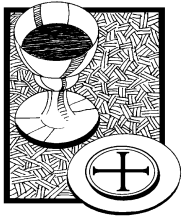

Fr. Michael will be away for a few days at Madonna House for his annual Associate's Priest's Meeting there.



Our readings this weekend speak of doing little things well. It is a theme found throughout Holy Scripture, and one found in many forms of Christian spirituality. Perhaps the one most known is that of St. Therese of the Little Flower, who modelled doing little things well for love of God and neighbour throughout her short life. Her “Story of a Soul” has inspired a great number of Christians throughout the world and has become for many a simple way of incarnating Christian living in the busyness of daily life.

Catherine Doherty was quite eclectic, in many respects, in drawing upon the rich treasury of our tradition. She knew that each one of us was called to become holy, by virtue of our Baptism, and she also knew that the key to holiness was through doing all the ordinary things of our daily life with an extraordinary love for God and our neighbour. Her “duty of the moment” was a reflection of this: if the floor needs to be swept, then sweeping it is the holiest thing a person can do at that time, and doing that little task with love for God and neighbour was the way to become united with God in our daily life, not to mention a means of transforming the world.

All that ‘prelude’ as a way of mentioning that I’ll be at Madonna House for a few days this week. As an Associate Priest of Madonna House, I try to visit whenever possible – not to mention that I have a truck load of donations to bring down from our Parish. They are mostly surplus office supplies that came from our parish office in Capreol, and which are not needed here. Madonna House will put them to good use.

Of course too, ARISE is one of those “little things” that come along in our lives every so often. It is a simple invitation to do a simple thing: meet with a group of other Christians who seek to find the face and hand of God in the daily dance of our lives. Like all invitations, it needs a response. I do hope many respond with an open heart and participate in this time of renewal. We are coming to the end of “The Year of Faith”, but the invitation to deepen our faith is ongoing.

Additionally, all who wish to be a part of the choir singing at this Mass are welcome to join in.

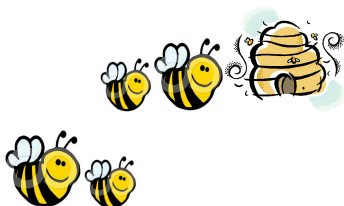
There is only one rehearsal, scheduled for **Wednesday, September 25th at 7pm** at Christ the King Church.
