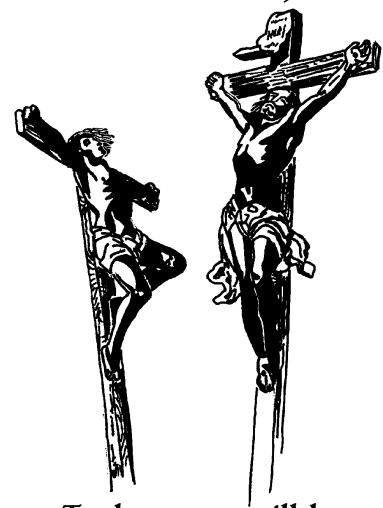

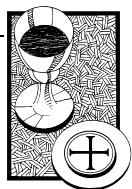

Audrey Conway, the mother of Fr. Paul Conway, died on November 14th. Her funeral was celebrated in Mississauga last Thursday. Many of you know Fr. Paul from when he was Pastor of St. Kevin from 1995 – 1997.

We are striving to be as responsible stewards as possible of the environment, and can use the help of everyone. We use the green bin for all paper towels – so it would help greatly if the garbage cans in the washrooms were used ONLY for paper towels.

There is also, finally, a blue box in the kitchen for our recyclables. Together, let us strive to reduce what is sent to our landfill.

During the month of November, we pray in a more particular way for those who have died. During this month, the Parish “In Memoriam” book has been placed in the Sanctuary, and all Masses will include those who have been enrolled as part of the daily intention.
