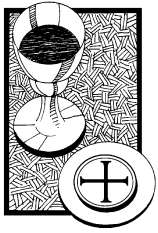

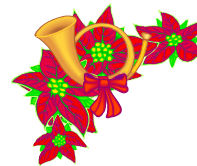

Fr. Michael will celebrate Mass at the Elizabeth Center on Friday morning this week, beginning at 10:30, in addition to the regularly scheduled Mass in our Parish at 9:30.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL:

Our PPC meets in Capreol on Wednesday evening this week. This meeting is for PPC members only, all of whom should have received your agenda for this meeting through e-mail.

REFUGEE FUNDRAISER:

On Sun. Nov. 29, the voices of 60 young people will ring out in Capreol, in support of the Syrian refugee family who will join our community in the coming year. The concert features the Young Sudbury Singers, made up of 2 choirs of about 40 voices. They will be joined by the 20 voice choir of C.R. Judd Elementary School, and some other local "young at heart" voices to present uplifting music. The Voices of Hope Concert will support the Capreol-Valley Refugee Sponsorship. Donations over \$20 are will be eligible for tax receipts, and all donations are welcome. Come, be uplifted, and spread hope. The concert begins at 2pm and will take place at Trinity United Church in Capreol.



REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP CORNER

The second meeting of the Capreol-Valley Refugee Sponsorship Committee took place on Tuesday evening this past week. Here are a few notes arising from that meeting:

Curtis Arcand has created a Face Book Page for us, as well as our logo (which can be seen on the posters on our bulletin boards). Thank you to Laurie Gagnon for creating the poster.

The Rectory in Capreol is being prepared. An inventory of what is there has been established, and a list of needs is being created. A Parishioner has offered to supply all needed beds and furniture items. A list of needed repairs is also being made, and volunteers have been identified who will look after those repairs.

With the assistance of Ted Hargreaves (Diocesan Financial Administrator), a legal contract has been drawn up to lease the Rectory to the United Church for use as a home for our refugee family for up to three years. The lease will be 'revenue neutral', once the needed motions are passed in a few weeks by the Parish Pastoral Council and the Finance Committee. The contract itself will be signed in December.

The necessary paperwork for our sponsorship is being processed. We are not yet at the stage of being able to correspond with our family, but we hope to reach that stage early next year.

Fundraising continues through a variety of approaches. Your envelope donations continue to be appreciated, and we encourage your ongoing support.

Contacts have been made with local families with roots in Syria, and they have been very generous in their offers of assistance in many areas, including translation.

A lot of work has been done. A lot more lay ahead. We are, however, well positioned to accept our family whenever they arrive. Please continue to pray for them. They are a Syrian family of nine living in a refugee camp in Lebanon.
