He was first stationed in Blind River in 2011, where he was responsible for St. James, Blessed Kateri (Mississauga) and St. Ambrose (Thessalon). In 2015, Fr. Jackson became the Associate Pastor at Holy Redeemer Parish (Sudbury), where he has served for the past 2 years.

We look forward to welcoming our new pastor in seven weeks, and wish Fr. Michael well in his new assignment.
