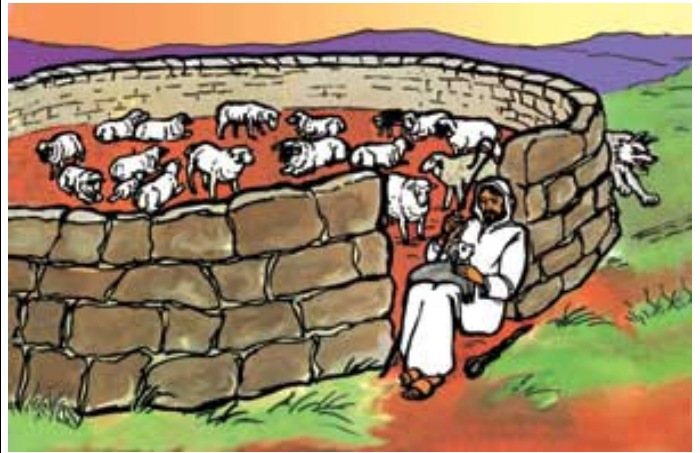

3. DISCOVER - September and October - The collated results will be shared publicly.
