





The new General Instruction of the Roman Missal asks us to enter into Mass with quieted souls. They put it this way: “Even before the celebration itself, it is a praiseworthy practice for silence to be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred celebration in a devout and fitting manner.”

My own casual observation over the past 20 months is that this is not so much observed in our setting. I believe it is because everyone is so thrilled to see me once each week, that nobody is able to contain their excitement. Although everyone is able to control themselves enough so as not to do cartwheels (thank goodness!), the giddiness is palpable and is given expression through all manner of voice. I understand. The Church presents us with a liturgical ideal, and we have to strive after it in our own context to the best of our abilities.

So, given our reality, and knowing that we are a small community of friends rather than a large impersonal Cathedral, we will try to move in the direction of silence, while maintaining our friendly banter (but please, no cartwheels until after Mass!). We will do this by introducing a brief period of prayer before Mass begins. The form of that prayer will be simple and in common, as a means of uniting our voices before God with a view to preparing to participate in the great mystery about to unfold in our midst. Our prayer, then, for the next 3 years, will be the ARISE prayer, since the ARISE process will be unfolding in our Parish over that period of time. We have received enough of the ARISE prayer cards to give each Parishioner one to take home. Please use it as you see fit in your personal and family prayer. The balance of the prayer cards are in the process of being laminated. These we will leave in our pews in order that we can pray the words together before all our Sunday Masses.

The cards are available now, if you wish to take one, in the entranceway of our respective worship sites. The ones for the pews will be available for our use shortly, after which we will begin to use them in our ‘prayer before Mass’. Hopefully, they will help us to enter into the great mystery of the Eucharist with quieted souls, such that we are more receptive to the gift of God’s love offered us always, but perceived more clearly when our hearts are still and our minds are turned to Him in that stillness.
