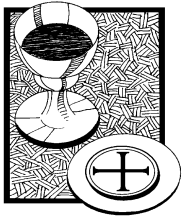

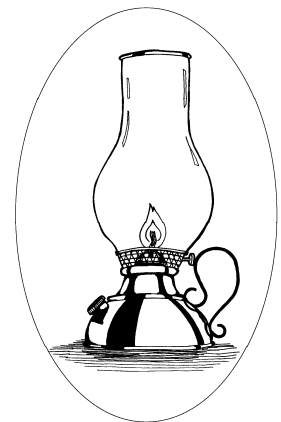

CANDLES AS PRAYER:

Starting this weekend, there will be some changes in the way we accommodate the burning of candles at our Worship Sites. Currently, this is done only at Our Lady of Peace, but the option will soon also be available at St. Kevin's.

Obviously, the burning of a candle does not make someone's prayer more 'effective'. Rather, it is an external 'sacramental' which reflects our inner hope of uniting our needs to God's heart.

What does make prayer more effective, however, is charity. Giving alms to the poor, or doing a work of charity, is a way of uniting our hearts to God's heart and has deep roots in Sacred Scripture and all through our Christian history.

Given all this, the changes: for those who wish to purchase and light a candle at one of our worship sites (and again, this is pending at St. Kevin's), the cost will be \$10.00. That entire \$10.00 will then be donated to the poor, mostly through our own local agencies (Bread and Roses and St. Vincent de Paul). In this way, your donation to the poor becomes symbolized through the lit candle, and your prayer becomes rooted in charitable action.

The Parish will also participate in your prayer in this way, as the Parish will absorb the cost of the candle. Again, all \$10.00 will be given away to the poor. Although the change will see a significant increase in the cost of the candle, it will also see a corresponding increase in our service of the poor. That is a prayer most pleasing to God.

The Blue Door Cafe (Soup Kitchen) is in desperate need of men's boots, running shoes and hoodies.



CONFIRMATION:

No longer having an Auxiliary Bishop to assist him, Bishop Plouffe is not celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation at every Parish every year. His schedule is based on the number of those to be confirmed; in this Parish, he has opted to come every 3rd year.

Be that as it may, even though we would not normally be scheduled for Confirmation until late 2015, Fr. Michael will be requesting that this Sacrament be celebrated here in the fall of this year instead. Three years is too long to wait.

As soon as we know if this can happen (we will likely know by late spring), information re: registration will be printed in the Sunday bulletin.

PARISH LEADERSHIP TEAM:

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND HOLY EUCHARIST:

By now, everyone who is preparing to receive Holy Communion **this** spring should have received a letter from Fr. Michael re: the upcoming preparation process. If you have not, please get in touch with Fr. Michael as soon as possible.

Also, for those wishing to enrol in the preparation process for Reconciliation and Holy Communion for the **next** year (beginning this fall), registration forms for these Sacraments **are available now** from Fr. Michael following any Sunday Mass. Anyone who will be eight years of age or older by the end of this year may register.

If you have a unique situation (unbaptized child, baptism in a different faith tradition, grandparents who are taking responsibility for their grandchild's faith, etc.), please speak to Fr. Michael privately, and we'll find a way to accommodate your situation.
