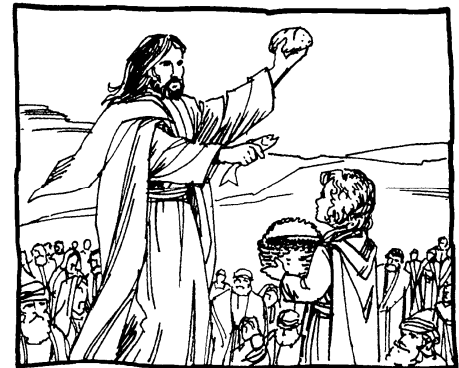

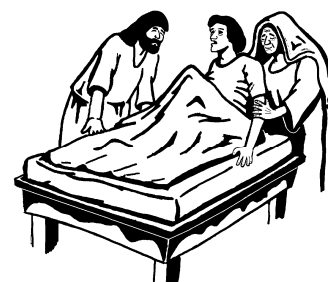

PARISH COUNCIL:

The full minutes of our last meeting held on May 18th are available on our Parish website. The following is a summary of the conclusions we reached following the discussion of several items:

1. Fr. Michael gave an update of the status of our initiative to sponsor a second family of refugees, as per the community meeting on March 29th. The full report of that meeting is attached to the minutes posted on our website. We are in waiting mode, and it may be some time (over a year) before we receive a second family.
2. The CWL is moving ahead with organizing a bus trip pilgrimage to Quebec City (Holy Door) this fall. The bus is already more than half filled.
3. Fr. Michael spoke about the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace, and indicated it as the “go to” organization for any parishioners wanting to become more involved in international justice issues on behalf of the parish.
4. Approval was given for the installation of a drying umbrella on our property in Capreol for use by the Alzahran family.
5. A discussion around advertising in our parish bulletin concluded with Fr. Michael requesting a business case for it being presented by those who are interested in pursuing this.

Our next meeting date has been set for September 21st.
