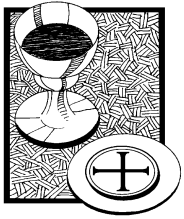

SOUND SYSTEM UPDATE:

This is still a work in process at our St. Kevin's Site. Since a permanent solution will not happen before the end of the month, stay tuned for a report in our fall bulletins on how things have progressed through the summer months.

OFFICE CLOSED:

As has been our practice, the Parish office will be closed during the summer months of July and August (closes June 28th – **this Friday** - and reopens September 2nd). Fr. Michael will be around all summer, and so will be available for anything that requires immediate attention.

A few things to note:

First,

if you need to contact Fr. Michael during the summer, you can leave a phone message at the office, or you can e-mail him at his parish address (pastor@stkevinparish.ca). Do NOT use the e-mail address with the "secretary" heading if you will require a speedy response, as this address will not be monitored except occasionally.

Second,

the last Parish bulletin for the season will be published on June 29th (just 1 more bulletin after this one), so if any Parish groups or committees need to publish information to the Parish, you have only 1 week left to do it. The next bulletin after that will be published on September 7th.

Finally,

the weekly Mass intentions will be posted on the main doors of the Church (St. Kevin Site) or the bulletin board (Our Lady of Peace Site). The summer Mass schedule will not change from the norm; if there are changes needed due to arising circumstances, these will be noted as we go along.

Please note that the CALENDAR PAGE on our Parish Website is always kept up to date, including during the summer months. If there are any changes to our Mass or Reconciliation schedule, they will be noted there first, along with any funerals that may arise.
