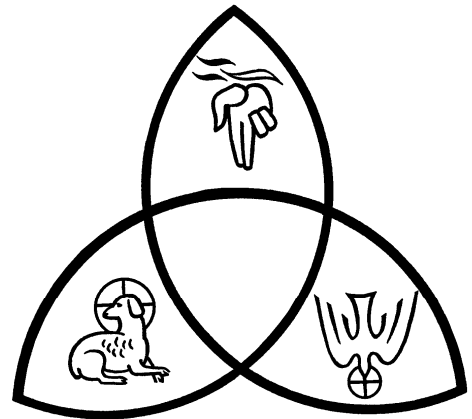

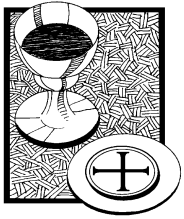

**SOUND SYSTEM UPDATE:**

As some are aware, the sound system at our St. Kevin Site died just before Easter. A quick fuse change on Holy Thursday gave us some sound, but we have recently discovered that our mixer board and amplifier have been terminal for some time, and our sound quality has been dropping quite considerably over the past several or more years.

We are currently using a borrowed amplifier as a temporary measure while we work towards a more permanent solution. You may have noticed the sound quality has improved over the past few weeks because of this borrowed system.

The permanent solution is being worked out, in terms of what is the best solution for our situation, and we hope to make a decision soon on what is the best course of action.

Meanwhile, we appreciate your patience as we work on this vital repair.

Do NOT use the e-mail address with the “secretary” heading if you will require a speedy response, as this address will not be monitored except occasionally.

Second, the last Parish bulletin for the season will be published on June 29<sup>th</sup> (just 2 more bulletins after this one), so if any Parish groups or committees need to publish information to the Parish, you have only 2 weeks left to do it. The next bulletin after that will be published on September 7<sup>th</sup>.

Finally, the weekly Mass intentions will be posted on the main doors of the Church (St. Kevin Site) or the bulletin board (Our Lady of Peace Site). The summer Mass schedule will not change from the norm; if there are changes needed due to arising circumstances, these will be noted as we go along.
