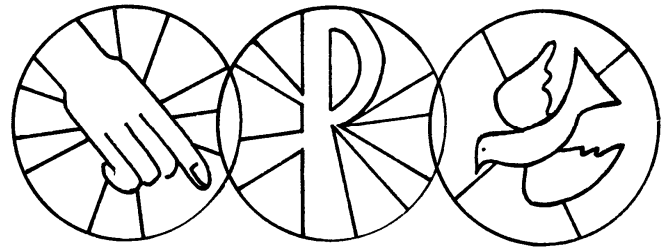

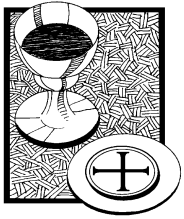

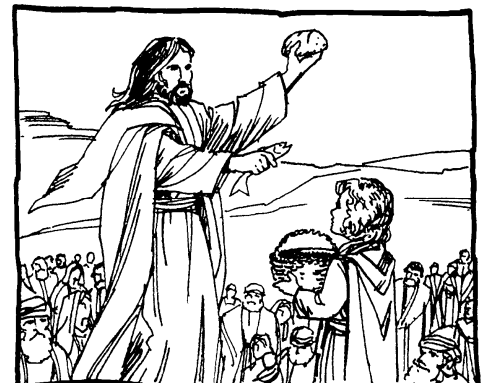

THEO YEAR OF FAITH 2012 TOKOS

This being the “Year of Faith”, it seems most appropriate to celebrate our faith, even as we strive to nourish and deepen it through our daily prayer and practice. So, celebrate is what we will do next weekend. We are pleased that Bishop Plouffe will be here to celebrate our Saturday evening Mass, and to join us for dinner afterwards. We are also pleased that 4 of our “Past Pastors” will be joining us: Frs. Sullivan, Doherty, Lalonde and Rymes. And, of course, we are ecstatic that so many of our current parishioners will be joining in our celebration. After all, 94 years of faith lived in Capreol, and 50 years of faith lived in Valley East, bears witness to the deep Christian roots which have grown in this part of Sudbury and have borne fruit in your lives. You, in turn, have shared and will continue to share your faith with others so that future generations may also come to know the Good News of Jesus Christ, Who has redeemed us from our sins and is alive in our midst. All this calls for celebration.

Faith, of course, is not something we possess, but is a gift given us by God. It is known to exist in our lives by the fruit our lives bear in love and service of others. We celebrate this coming weekend ‘what has been’, but only because we are called to continue walking in this lived faith of our parish community with a view to ‘what will be’, all the while proclaiming Christ present here today.

BE A PART OF OUR FAMILY PHOTO:
