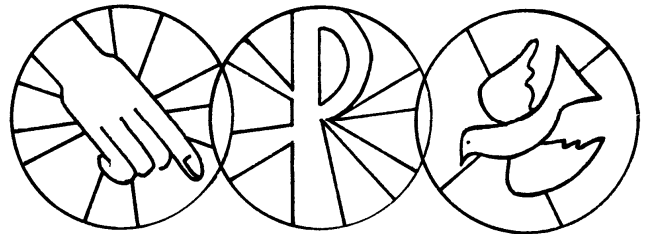

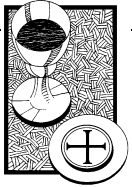

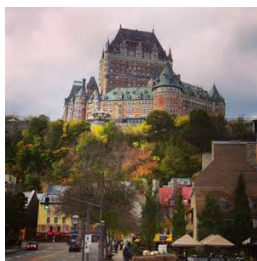
Society of St. Vincent de Paul - St. Kevin's Conference

MARCH FOR LIFE:

The Annual March for Life was held on Thursday, May 12th in Ottawa on Parliament Hill. Fr. Michael attended with a number of parishioners who either drove together or took the bus organized by the Diocese.

Most of us participated in the candle light prayer vigil at the monument to human rights on Wednesday night. We also attended Mass at Notre-Dame Cathedral Basilica on Thursday morning, which was celebrated by Archbishop Prendergast, with the homily given by Cardinal Collins.

A large number of MPs, Senators and other dignitaries began their speeches at Noon on Parliament Hill, where the gathering participants filled the entirety of the lawn. The March began at 1:30, following a route through downtown Ottawa, and it took nearly 90 minutes for it to be completed by everyone. The police were very good in ensuring a safe afternoon through traffic control and the closing of affected streets.

This is the second largest gathering on Parliament Hill, year after year, second only to Canada Day. The media, for the most part, ignores or downplays it. However, the truth is spoken by the numbers – all human life is worthy of respect, no matter how young or how old, how fit or how disabled. Thank you to everyone who prayed for our safety and who continue to pray for a turning back of the culture of death in our land.
